The wastewater report for the month of June 2024 is as follows. The Poplar Water Treatment and Wastewater Treatment Systems experienced brief interruption on 6/23/24. The interruption is determined to be caused from weather as multiple local locations experienced brief power outages. On 6/25/24 Influent flow monitoring instrumentation was determined inoperable and a new Transducer and Panel is required for Influent monitoring (Influent is the incoming wastewater from the community and the transducer and panel monitor the flow and transmit the information to a flow chart that is recorded for state required reporting as well as district records and reference). Multiple call for service were requested on the following dates at the locations listed on 6/17/24 @ 14709 Walker Rd, 6/21/24 @ 14551 Tobias Rd, 6/24/24 @ 19157 Ave. 148. All calls for service were determined to be district responsibility and were resolved without issue. Laboratory results have came back within discharge requirements and Well depths are as follows
